2024/101 Minutes of previous meetings

b) **Council received** an update on matters from the minutes not appearing anywhere on the agenda from the clerk.

Holocaust Service was well attended with lovely readings by SJN children and members of the Jewish community. Thanks to Keith for once again helping me set up and to Brigg Heritage Centre for opening up and serving refreshments and washing up etc It was agreed to write a letter of thanks to the Volunteers of the Heritage Centre.

Struggling to source Sakura trees of substantial growth. Not on NLC list of accessible trees. Each tree is coming out at over £100 each plus guards etc. – Agenda item.

Christmas Lights have been very well received. Disappointed about East Park but it was found the old wrapping had split and kept tripping out local area. So will need to address further trees being wrapped this year. The East Park wrapping was not part of the scheme only the lighting. So two trees per year will add £4922 annually. Agenda item next meeting.

2024/102 - Ward Councillors report

Cllr Waltham

Wrawby Road – a temporary path has been installed and the developer has been made to clean the road more frequently. NLC has taken action to ensure this is carried out.

Devolution – Mayoral Elections will take place on 1st May 2025. Cllr Waltham selected as Conservative Candidate. If successful will still remain a Brigg Town Councillor, but can not remain a Brigg and Wolds Ward Councillor at North Lincolnshire Council.

Local Govt. reorganisation will not affect North Lincolnshire Council for the foreseeable future. Authorities such as Leicester are being looked at first, but not ones with a Devolution agreement at the moment.

Central Government have imposed a decision that if Local Authorities do not increase their Council Tax by the full amount then the grant to Council will be removed. This is disappointing as NLC has tried to keep Council Tax low while maintaining high values. Inevitably Council Tax will need to ruse this year.

Cllr Smith raised the situation around the Market Stalls, advising that she has been contacted by many shop owners and residents that they are unsightly and hard to navigate in mobility scooters. Cllr Sherwood advised that the situation is not permanent, and traders and shop owners affected have been notified of this. Cllr Waltham advised that tenders are being sought for a new contractor for the market stalls. Note that the Market Stall rent is the cheapest in the country and that many towns have market stall out all year round.
