a) **PA/2025/99** Listed Building Consent for installation of extract and ventilation equipment, plant and bin enclosure and internal and external fit-out work, The Old Chapel, Bridge Street, Brigg, DN20 8LP

Comments - Brigg Town Council objects to listed building consent being approved.

The building is a grade 2 listed building within the conservation area of Brigg. The proposed aluminium doors are detrimental and not in keeping with a grade 2 listed building.

The proposed extraction ventilation is not in keeping with a grade 2 listed building within the conservation area.

The plastic signage is not in keeping with a grade 2 listed building within the conservation area.

b) **PA/2025/45** permission for change of use of vacant shop (Class E) to hot food takeaway (sui generis), installation of extract and ventilation equipment and erection of plant/bin enclosure, The Old Chapel, Bridge Street, Brigg, DN20 8LP.

Comments - Brigg Town Council object to this application.

Whilst Brigg Town Council actively support businesses in the town and support this disused building being brought back into use, it objects to a fast food outlet being granted permission for this site.

The increased parking with it being a proposed takeaway food establishment will increase vehicular movements. The lack of sufficient parking is a highway safety concern

The building is a grade 2 listed building within the conservation area of Brigg and the aluminum doors and external extraction flues are not in keeping with a building such as this.

There will be increased drainage concerns on an already overloaded drainage system, with the increased chance of food waste and fats being added to the system.

The increased litter is inevitable in the town and a risk to the environment.
